RE: Recommended Veto of AB 1505 (O'Donnell)

Dear Governor Newsom:

I respectfully write to request your veto of Assembly Bill 1505, which adds new reasons a local governing board may deny a charter petition; limits review of charter denial appeals; alters charter renewals from 5 years to 2-7 years; and suspends the approval of a petition for the establishment of a new nonclassroom-based charter schools

This bill allows school districts to reject a charter petition for broad and nebulous reasons that would be easy for any board to gin up. It also limits appeals of new charters to the State Board of Education by limiting the SBE's reason to overturn a denial to a finding that a district "abused its discretion." Again, any district that wanted to find a reason to deny a petition could easily do so; thus, the ability for the SBE to overturn a denial is effectively eliminated. Lastly, the bill eliminates "increases in academic achievement" as the most important factor in charter renewal or revocation. This makes no sense, and does a sad disservice to dedicated educators and hardworking students.

For these reasons, I respectfully request your veto.
